For refund purposes, the weeks begins on Sunday and Ends on Saturday. Any part of a week is considered a full week.

Daisey vessel is available for two hours and four hours trips. A flat rate of \$600 for up to 18 individuals will be charged for two-hour trips. \$35.00 per person will be charged for anyone over the minimum amount. Four hours is charge at a flat rate of \$1,200 for up to 18 individuals. Everyone over the minimum amount will be charged \$65 per person. Each class gets a total of 3 2-hour Daisey trips or 1 2-hour Daisey trip and 1 (3-5 hour) ODU trip.

For ODU Vessel Trips there must be a minimum of 10 people to go for the trip (3 hours MA).

For 11 Participants, 4 hours on the vessel.

For 12-15 participants, 5 hours on the vessel.

Classes can combine together to go on the trip but when sharing vessels it takes away from both classes and not ust one.

If the class e ceeds either of the limits (min/ma) then the participants are sub equaly the remaining balance.

CBFS vans used by field trips will be charge an addition cost of \$0.60 per mile.

Lost or damaged equipment must be replaced at cost by the university.

Lost key replacement cost is \$40 for students or faculty.

Damages to property including residence halls, vessel, etc. will be billed to the university at cost.

Park entrance fees, meal or housing off campus or other fees will not be covered or refunded by CBFS.

Summer students residing in housing are required to participate in the meal plan.
