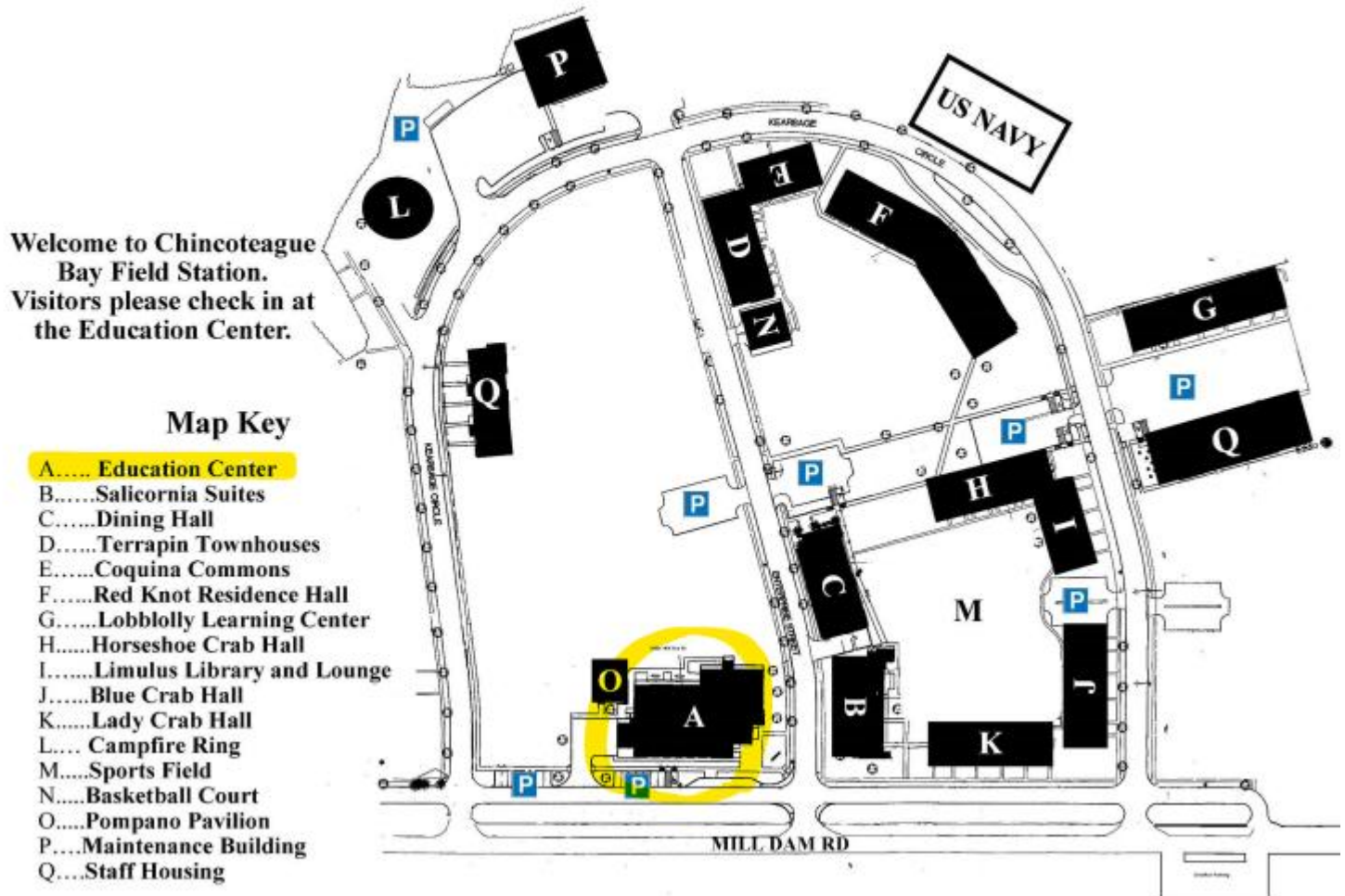
Check-In will begin at 8:30 AM in the lobby of our Education Center (building A on the map below). Parking is available along the road as well as our various parking lots on camps.
